Enclosed for consideration and approval by the Council of the District of Columbia is proposed emergency legislation, the "Multiyear Modification No. M022, under Multiyear Contract No. DCKA-2011-C-0121, Emergency Approval Resolution of 2014" and the accompanying declaration resolution to approve multiyear Modification No. M022 under Contract No. DCKA-2011-C-0121 with Ratp Dev McDonald Transit LLC., to increase the Contract ceiling to allow capacity for additional operation and maintenance services related to the DC Streetcar Program. Approval is necessary to allow the District to receive the benefit of these vital services, and the critical requirements of the District can only be met through an award of the approved multiyear Modification No. M022 with Ratp Dev McDonald Transit LLC.

Council approval is required by section 451(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973, 87 Stat. 803, Pub. L. 93-198; D.C. Official Code 1-204.52(c)(3).


The estimated increase in the ceiling price for the term of this multiyear Modification No. M022 with Ratp Dev McDonald Transit LLC, is in the amount of \$10,402,956.22. The term will be from the date of award of Modification No. 22, through June 28, 2017.

There are three five-year option periods. The Agency Fiscal Officer for the DC Department of Transportation has certified that funding is available and consistent with the agency budget for FY15, FY16, and FY 17.



A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Multiyear Modification No. M022, under Multiyear Contract No. DCKA-2011-C-0121 with Ratp Dev McDonald Transit LLC, to increase the Contract ceiling to allow capacity for additional operation and maintenance services related to the DC Streetcar Program.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That
this resolution may be cited as the “Multiyear Modification No. M022 under Contract No. DCKA-2011-C-0121 Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2014”.

Sec. 2. (a) The District Department of Transportation proposes to enter into multiyear Modification No. M022, under Contract No. DCKA-2011-C-0121 with Ratp Dev McDonald Transit LLC, to increase the Contract ceiling to allow capacity for additional operation and maintenance services related to the DC Streetcar Program.

(b) The estimated increase in the ceiling price for the term of this multiyear Modification No. M022 contract with Ratp Dev McDonald Transit LLC, is in the amount of \$10,402,956.22, which will increase the Contract ceiling to \$32,417,129.42.

(c) Approval is necessary to allow the District to continue to receive the benefit of these vital services without interruption from Ratp Dev McDonald Transit LLC.

1 (d) These critical services can only be obtained through an award of the
2 multiyear modification under the contract with Ratp Dev McDonald Transit LLC.

3 Sec 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
4 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
5 Multiyear Modification No. M022, under Contract No. DCKA-2011-C-0121, Emergency
6 Declaration Resolution of 2014 be adopted after a single reading.

7 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
