In addition to my full scope responsibilities, I was the contact lens specialist of this practice. My specialty fits range from diseased/degenerative corneal fits to specialty pediatric fits that range from aphakia to occlusive contact fits for amblyopia. I had staff privileges at NorthEast Hospital, Concord, North Carolina, to share "on-call" responsibilities for emergency eye care and inpatient consults. I gave various public education lectures to area seniors. I biannually gave JCAHPO approved lectures for county wide ophthalmic technician meetings.
