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is employed, by a law enforcement agency <u>or a correctional</u> <u>agency</u> for the principal purpose of aiding in the detection of criminal activity, enforcement of laws, or apprehension of offenders.

- (b) "Fire canine dog" means any canine dog that is owned, or the service of which is employed, by a fire department, a special fire district, or the State Fire Marshal for the principal purpose of aiding in the detection of flammable materials or the investigation of fires.
- (c) "SAR canine dog" means any search and rescue canine dog that is owned, or the service of which is employed utilized, by a fire department, a law enforcement agency, a correctional agency, a special fire district, or the State Fire Marshal for the principal purpose of aiding in the detection of missing persons, including, but not limited to, persons who are lost, who are trapped under debris as the result of a natural, manmade, or technological disaster, or who are drowning victims.
- (2) Any person who intentionally and knowingly, without lawful cause or justification, causes great bodily harm, permanent disability, or death to, or uses a deadly weapon upon, a police canine dog, fire canine dog, SAR canine dog, or police horse commits a felony of the second third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
- (3) Any person who actually and intentionally maliciously touches, strikes, or causes bodily harm to a police canine dog,

fire <u>canine</u> <u>dog</u>, SAR <u>canine</u> <u>dog</u>, or police horse commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

- (4) Any person who intentionally or knowingly maliciously harasses, teases, interferes with, or attempts to interfere with a police canine dog, fire canine dog, SAR canine dog, or police horse while the animal is in the performance of its duties commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (5) A person convicted of an offense under this section shall make restitution for injuries caused to the police <u>canine</u> dog, fire <u>canine</u> dog, SAR <u>canine</u> dog, or police horse and shall pay the replacement cost of the animal if, as a result of the offense, the animal can no longer perform its duties.
