A bill to be entitled

An act relating to subpoenas; amending s. 92.605, F.S.; revising requirements for service of a subpoena on an out-of-state corporation doing business in this state primarily through the Internet; authorizing an investigative or law enforcement officer conducting an investigation to petition a court to compel compliance with a subpoena; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Paragraph (h) of subsection (1) of section 92.605, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (10) is added to that section, to read:
- 92.605 Production of certain records by Florida businesses and out-of-state corporations.—
 - (1) For the purposes of this section, the term:
- (h) "Properly served" means delivery by hand or in a manner reasonably allowing for proof of delivery if delivered by United States mail, overnight delivery service, or facsimile to a person or entity properly registered to do business in any state. In order for an out-of-state corporation to be properly served, the service described in this paragraph must be effected on the corporation's registered agent. Service on an out-of-state corporation doing business in this state primarily through

- (10) In the case of a corporation's contumacy or failure to comply with a subpoena issued under this section on behalf of an investigative or law enforcement officer conducting an investigation, the investigative or law enforcement officer who sought the subpoena may petition a court of competent jurisdiction to compel compliance. The court may use any powers available to it to compel compliance.
