House Memorial

A memorial to the Congress of the United States, urging Congress to ensure that the United States

Department of Veterans Affairs sufficiently implements both the letter and spirit of the VA Maintaining

Internal Systems and Strengthening Integrated Outside Networks (MISSION) Act of 2018.

WHEREAS, Florida has the third largest veteran population in the United States at approximately 1.6 million veterans, each of whose health and well-being are of utmost importance to the members of the Florida Legislature, and

WHEREAS, despite being charged with ensuring the health and well-being of Florida's veterans, the United States Department of Veterans Affairs has, in recent years, failed to timely deliver the quality of care these veterans deserve, and

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2018, President Donald Trump signed into law the bipartisan VA Maintaining Internal Systems and Strengthening Integrated Outside Networks (MISSION) Act of 2018, which was supported by more than 30 veteran and military service organizations, and

WHEREAS, the VA MISSION Act of 2018 requires an overhaul and modernization of the VA health care system and, when properly implemented, will preserve the beneficial aspects of the VA health care system while providing veterans increased

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health care options through a new and consolidated Veterans Community Care Program, and

WHEREAS, to better serve Florida's veterans, the VA MISSION Act of 2018 authorizes the United States Department of Veterans Affairs to enter into community provider agreements with the eight veterans' homes operated by the State of Florida, allowing these homes to seamlessly partner with the VA without being subject to additional federal regulations, and

WHEREAS, the VA MISSION Act of 2018 expands access to the United States Department of Veterans Affairs Family Caregiver Program to all veterans who have incurred or aggravated serious injuries while serving on active duty in the military, rather than only those serving since September 11, 2001, and also establishes an information-sharing process to ensure that community care providers employ safe opioid prescribing practices at facilities where veterans receive care, and

WHEREAS, successful implementation of the VA MISSION Act of 2018 requires access to the highest quality of health care both inside and outside the VA system through the timely publication of clear access and quality standards, seamless access to walkin care, innovation in care delivery and claims processing, and meeting key deadlines provided in the act as the United States Department of Veterans Affairs reviews its infrastructure needs, NOW, THEREFORE,

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Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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That the Florida Legislature supports the passage of the VA Maintaining Internal Systems and Strengthening Integrated Outside Networks (MISSION) Act of 2018 and urges Congress to ensure successful implementation by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs consistent with the letter and spirit in which the act was written.
