The order of taking shall not become 17 effective unless the deposit of the required sum is made in the 18 registry of the court. If the deposit is not made within 20 days 19 20 from the date of the order of taking, the order shall be void 21 and of no further effect. The clerk is authorized to invest such 22 deposits so as to earn the highest interest obtainable under the 23 circumstances in state or national financial institutions in 24 Florida insured by the Federal Government. Ninety percent of the 25 interest earned shall be allocated in accordance with the 26 ultimate ownership in the deposit paid to the petitioner. 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
