A bill to be entitled

An act relating to mental health crisis intervention training for law enforcement officers; amending s. 943.17, F.S.; providing requirements for mental health crisis intervention skills training for law enforcement officers; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (8) is added to section 943.17, Florida Statutes, to read:

943.17 Basic recruit, advanced, and career development training programs; participation; cost; evaluation.—The commission shall, by rule, design, implement, maintain, evaluate, and revise entry requirements and job-related curricula and performance standards for basic recruit, advanced, and career development training programs and courses. The rules shall include, but are not limited to, a methodology to assess relevance of the subject matter to the job, student performance, and instructor competency.

(8) By July 1, 2025, the commission, in consultation with a national organization with expertise in mental health crisis intervention, shall establish minimum standards for basic skills and continued education training for law enforcement officers that includes mental health crisis intervention training. training shall improve officers' knowledge and skills as first
responders to incidents involving persons with emotional
disturbance or mental illness, including those with co-occurring
substance use disorders, and incorporating de-escalation skills
to ensure an effective law enforcement response and officer
safety. Thereafter, every basic skills course curriculum
required for law enforcement officers to obtain their initial
certification shall include a 40-hour curriculum on mental
health crisis intervention and a minimum of 8 hours of
continuing education courses annually.
