A bill to be entitled

An act relating to education; amending s. 1001.43, F.S.; making a technical change; requiring a district school board to allow a student to wear a dress uniform of the United States Armed Forces or the National Guard at a high school graduation ceremony under certain circumstances; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (8) of section 1001.43, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1001.43 Supplemental powers and duties of district school board.—The district school board may exercise the following supplemental powers and duties as authorized by this code or State Board of Education rule.

(8) STUDENT ASSESSMENT AND AFFAIRS.—The district school board may adopt policies and procedures governing attendance monitoring and checks; truancy; graduation requirements and graduation exercises; fees, fines, and charges imposed on students; evaluation of student records and transcripts; transfer of student records; grading and academic evaluation of students; tests and examinations, including early examinations; guidance and counseling; and student participation in

competitions, student performances and exhibitions, contests for students, and social events; and graduation requirements and graduation exercises. A district school board shall allow a student to wear a dress uniform issued to the student by a branch of the United States Armed Forces or the National Guard while participating in the student's high school graduation ceremony if the student has completed basic training for and is an active member of a branch of the United States Armed Forces or the National Guard.
