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- (2) In addition to any other remedies provided by law, the person taking possession of a dog or cat transferred under a contract described in subsection (1) is the owner of the dog or cat and is entitled to the return of all moneys paid under such contract.
- (3) This section does not apply to contracts to repay an unsecured loan for the purchase of a dog or cat.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
