11	Section 1. Section 633.415, Florida Statutes, is created

14	(1) A firefighter or volunteer firefighter may apply for a
15	Firefighter Emeritus designation if he or she:
16	(a) Has at least 20 years of service;
17	(b) Has been employed by a fire service provider, as
18	defined in s. 633.102(13), and is in good standing with his or
19	her most recent fire service provider; and
20	(c)1. Is recorded on a fire service provider roster in the
21	division's online electronic database or;
22	2. Was previously certified as a firefighter or volunteer
23	firefighter in this state.
24	(2) A firefighter may have his or her Firefighter
25	Certificate of Compliance or a Volunteer Firefighter Certificate

of Completion placed into Firefighter Emeritus designation by applying to the division at the time required to renew the certificate. The application shall be made on a form prescribed by the division.

- (3) A Firefighter Emeritus may not engage in firefighting activities with a fire department unless he or she holds a current and valid Firefighter Certificate of Compliance or Special Certificate of Compliance issued by the division under s. 633.408.
- (4) After the division approves a currently employed firefighter's Firefighter Emeritus designation, the division shall, after the firefighter's 4-year period pursuant to s. 633.414, issue in its online electronic database, the Firefighter Emeritus designation upon the end of such period.
- (5) If a firefighter's Firefighter Certificate of
 Compliance or a Volunteer Firefighter Certificate of Completion
 is current upon the approval of a Firefighter Emeritus
 designation, and he or she applies to renew such certification
 within the first 4 years after the date of such approval, he or
 she must successfully complete the Minimum Standards course
 examination.
- (6) If a firefighter's Firefighter Certificate of

 Compliance or a Volunteer Firefighter Certificate of Completion

 has expired upon the Firefighter Emeritus designation and he or

 she desires to perform firefighting services, the firefighter

53	(7) The division may adopt rules pursuant to its authority
