18	(d)1. For purposes of this paragraph, the term:
19	a. "Home addresses" means the dwelling location at which
20	an individual resides and includes the physical address, mailing
21	address, street address, parcel identification number, plot
22	identification number, legal property description, neighborhood
23	name and lot number, GPS coordinates, and any other descriptive
24	property information that may reveal the home address.
25	b. "Telephone numbers" includes home telephone numbers,

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26 personal cellular telephone numbers, personal pager telephone 27 numbers, and telephone numbers associated with personal 28 communications devices.

240 The home addresses, telephone numbers, dates of birth, s. 241 and photographs of current or former directors, managers, 242 supervisors, nurses, and clinical employees of an addiction 243 treatment facility; the home addresses, telephone numbers, 244 photographs, dates of birth, and places of employment of the 245 spouses and children of such personnel; and the names and 246 locations of schools and day care facilities attended by the 247 children of such personnel are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. For purposes of this 248 sub-subparagraph, the term "addiction treatment facility" means 249 250 a county government, or agency thereof, that is licensed

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pursuant to s. 397.401 and provides substance abuse prevention, intervention, or clinical treatment, including any licensed service component described in s. 397.311(26).

254 The home addresses, telephone numbers, dates of birth, t. 255 and photographs of current or former directors, managers, 256 supervisors, and clinical employees of a child advocacy center that meets the standards of s. 39.3035(1) and fulfills the 257 screening requirement of s. 39.3035(2), and the members of a 258 Child Protection Team as described in s. 39.303 whose duties 259 include supporting the investigation of child abuse or sexual 260 261 abuse, child abandonment, child neglect, and child exploitation 262 or to provide services as part of a multidisciplinary case review team; the names, home addresses, telephone numbers, 263 264 photographs, dates of birth, and places of employment of the 265 spouses and children of such personnel and members; and the 266 names and locations of schools and day care facilities attended 267 by the children of such personnel and members are exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. An agency that is the custodian of the information specified in subparagraph 2. and that is not the employer of the officer, employee, justice, judge, or other person specified in subparagraph 2. shall maintain the exempt status of that information only if the officer, employee, justice, judge, other person, or employing agency of the designated employee submits a written request for maintenance of the exemption to the

277	4. An officer, an employee, a justice, a judge, or other
278	person specified in subparagraph 2. may submit a written request
279	for the release of his or her exempt information to the
280	custodial agency. The written request must be notarized and must
281	specify the information to be released and the party that is
282	authorized to receive the information. Upon receipt of the
283	written request, the custodial agency shall release the
284	specified information to the party authorized to receive such
285	information.
286	5. The exemptions in this paragraph apply to information
287	held by an agency before, on, or after the effective date of the
288	exemption.
289	6. This paragraph is subject to the Open Government Sunset
290	Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed
291	on October 2, 2024, unless reviewed and saved from repeal
292	through reenactment by the Legislature.
293	Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public
294	necessity that the home addresses, dates of birth, and telephone
295	numbers of current or former judicial assistants; the names,
296	home addresses, telephone numbers, dates of birth, and places of
297	employment of the spouses and children of such judicial
298	assistants; and the names and locations of schools and day care
299	facilities attended by the children of such judicial assistants
300	be made exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s.

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301	24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. Such identifying and
302	location information can be used as a tool to perpetuate fraud
303	against an individual and to acquire sensitive personal,
304	financial, medical, and familial information, the release of
305	which could cause great financial harm to the individual. In the
306	course of assisting in making rulings, entering judgments,
307	imposing sentences, or reviewing cases, judicial assistants
308	frequently do not create good will with litigants, the accused,
309	the convicted, and their associates and families, thus making
310	the judicial assistants, and their spouses and children, targets
311	for acts of revenge. This risk continues after judicial
312	assistants complete their public service. Disgruntled
313	individuals may wait to commit an act of revenge until the
314	employment of a judicial assistant ends. If such identifying and
315	location information is released, the safety of current or
316	former judicial assistants and their spouses and children could
317	be seriously jeopardized. For these reasons, the Legislature
318	finds that it is a public necessity that such information be
319	made exempt from public records requirements.
320	Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.

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
