- (2) \underline{A} No for-profit corporation or any employee thereof \underline{may} not \underline{shall} transfer or arrange for the transfer of any human body part for valuable consideration.
- (3) A for-profit eye bank, as defined in s. 765.511, may not engage, directly or indirectly, in the procurement, as defined in s. 765.511, of any eye, cornea, eye tissue, or corneal tissue for use in live-cell corneal transplantation.
