class for creditable service within the purview of the Senior
Management Service Class retroactive to October 1, 2007, and may
upgrade retirement credit for such service in accordance with
paragraph (j). However, this service credit may not be purchased
by the employer on behalf of the member.
Section 2. For the 2020-2021 fiscal year, the sum of
\$288,234 in recurring funds is appropriated from the General
Revenue Fund to the offices of the Criminal Conflict and Civil
Regional Counsels for the purpose of paying retirement benefits
for specified positions within those offices.
Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
