Section 1. Section 366.025, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

366.025 Municipal electric utilities.—Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, a municipal electric utility may not use any revenues collected for providing electricity to its customers to finance general governmental functions, to purchase bonds to finance general governmental functions, or to lend money to the municipality to finance general governmental functions within the municipality. The municipal electric utility must use the revenues exclusively for electric utility operations and for building, maintaining, renovating, or otherwise improving the infrastructure of its electric utility facilities.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
