Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 1007.33, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1007.33 Site-determined baccalaureate degree access.-

- (2) Any Florida College System institution that offers one or more baccalaureate degree programs must:
 - (a) Must maintain as its primary mission:
- 1. Responsibility for responding to community needs for postsecondary academic education and career degree education as prescribed in s. 1004.65(5).
- 2. The provision of associate degrees that provide access to a university.
- (b) $\underline{\text{Must}}$ maintain an open-door admission policy for associate-level degree programs and workforce education programs.

- (d) Must continue to provide remedial education.
- (e) <u>Must</u> comply with all provisions of the statewide articulation agreement which relate to 2-year and 4-year public degree-granting institutions as adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to s. 1007.23.
 - (f) Must not award graduate credit.
