In 2018, voters approved an amendment to the State 22 (b) 23 Constitution that prohibits the racing of, and wagering on, 24 greyhounds after December 31, 2020. 25 As a result of the prohibition on greyhound racing and (C)

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wagering, thousands of people have lost or will lose their jobs, and racing greyhound and kennel owners will lose millions of dollars in property value.

- (d) It is appropriate and necessary to establish a fund to compensate those workers and property owners who have been adversely impacted as a result of the prohibition on greyhound racing and wagering.
- (e) In order to establish a compensation fund for those impacted by the prohibition on greyhound racing and wagering, it is necessary to redirect certain revenues generated in the parimutual wagering industry. This is proper because of the historic links between wagering on greyhound races and other forms of wagering in the state.
- (2) (a) The division shall select a statewide organization to distribute the proceeds of the Greyhound Racing Compensation Trust Fund to compensate those who have been adversely impacted as a result of the prohibition on greyhound racing and wagering. The division must select a statewide organization that was established to support greyhound racing in the state. The organization must:
- 1. Establish criteria and guidelines for disbursing funds to those adversely impacted by the prohibition on greyhound racing and wagering.
- 2. Provide an annual reporting of how the funds were spent, including administrative costs. the report shall be

- 3. Cooperate with an annual audit by the Joint Legislative Auditing Committee.
- (b) The division may adopt rules pursuant to s. 120.54 to implement this section.
- (3) The division shall determine the amount of money it has saved as a result of the decrease in greyhound racing, including, but not limited to, the reduction in the cost of inspections, testing, and overall operating expenses. Such funds must be deposited into the Greyhound Racing Compensation Trust Fund by July 1, 2020.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, but only if HB ___ or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes a law.
