23	(a) Notwithstanding s. 320.08053(1) and s. 45 of chapter
24	2008-176, Laws of Florida, as amended by s. 21 of chapter 2010-
25	223, Laws of Florida, the department shall develop a Florida
26	Homebuilders license plate as provided in this section and s.

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320.08053(2) and (3). The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and a slogan approved by the department must appear at the bottom of the plate.

(b) The department shall retain all annual use fees from the sale of such plates until the startup costs for developing and issuing the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the annual use fees shall be distributed to the Florida Home

Builders Association and local affiliates, which may use up to 10 percent of the proceeds for administrative costs and marketing of the plate. The balance of the fees shall be used by the Florida Home Builders Association and local affiliates to protect and to promote and educate the public about Florida's home building industry, ensuring that it remains a thriving component of this state's economy.

Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2014.
