Section 1. Paragraphs (d) and (e) of subsection (4) of section 790.33, Florida Statutes, are amended, and paragraph (f) is added to that subsection, to read:

790.33 Field of regulation of firearms and ammunition preempted.—

- (4) EXCEPTIONS.—This section does not prohibit:
- (d) A court or administrative law judge from hearing and resolving any case or controversy or issuing any opinion or order on a matter within the jurisdiction of that court or judge; $\frac{\partial}{\partial x}$
- (e) The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission from regulating the use of firearms or ammunition as a method of taking wildlife and regulating the shooting ranges managed by the commission; or
