HB 1199 2016

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A bill to be entitled

An act relating to racing greyhound injuries; creating s. 550.2416, F.S.; requiring injuries to racing greyhounds to be reported in the format prescribed by the Division of Pari-mutuel Wagering of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation within a certain timeframe; specifying information that must be included in the injury report; requiring the division to maintain the reports as public records for a specified time; specifying disciplinary action that may be taken against a licensee of the department who fails to report an injury or who makes false statements on an injury report; exempting injuries to certain animals from reporting requirements; requiring the division to adopt rules; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Section 550.2416, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

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550.2416 Reporting of racing greyhound injuries.-

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(1) An injury to a racing greyhound which occurs while the greyhound is located in this state must be reported in the format prescribed by the division within 7 days after the date

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on which the injury occurred or is believed to have occurred.

28	(2) The injury report shall be completed and signed under
29	oath or affirmation by the:
30	(a) Racetrack veterinarian or director of racing, if the
31	injury occurred at the racetrack facility; or
32	(b) Owner, trainer, or kennel operator who had knowledge
33	of the injury, if the injury occurred at a location other than
34	the racetrack facility, including during transportation.
35	(3) The division may fine, suspend, or revoke the license
36	of any individual who knowingly violates this section.
37	(4) The injury report must include the following:
38	(a) The greyhound's registered name, right-ear and left-
39	ear tattoo numbers, and, if any, the microchip manufacturer and
40	number.
41	(b) The name, business address, and telephone number of
42	the greyhound owner, the trainer, and the kennel operator.
43	(c) The color, weight, and sex of the greyhound.
44	(d) The specific type and bodily location of the injury,
45	the cause of the injury, and the estimated recovery time from
46	the injury.
47	(e) If the injury occurred when the greyhound was racing:
48	1. The racetrack where the injury occurred;
49	2. The distance, grade, race, and post position of the
50	greyhound when the injury occurred; and
51	3. The weather conditions, time, and track conditions when

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the injury occurred.

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<u>(f)</u>	Ιf	the	injury	occurred	when	the	greyhound	was	not
racing:									

- 1. The location where the injury occurred; and
- 2. The circumstances surrounding the injury.

- (g) Other information that the division determines is necessary to identify injuries to racing greyhounds in this state.
- (5) An injury report submitted to the division pursuant to this section shall be maintained as a public record by the division for at least 7 years after the date it is received.
- (6) A licensee of the department who knowingly makes a false statement concerning an injury or fails to report an injury is subject to disciplinary action under this chapter or chapters 455 and 474.
- (7) This section does not apply to injuries to a service animal, personal pet, or greyhound that has been adopted as a pet.
- (8) The division shall adopt rules to implement this section.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016.
