A bill to be entitled

An act relating to athletic, exercise, and physical fitness facilities; providing that the admissions tax may not be levied on the sale of athletic, exercise, and physical fitness facility memberships by certain health studios during a specified period; authorizing the Department of Revenue to adopt emergency rules; providing an appropriation; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Physical fitness admissions tax suspension.—

- (1) The tax levied under s. 212.04, Florida Statutes, may not be collected during the period from 12:01 a.m. on September 1, 2014, through 11:59 p.m. on September 8, 2014, on the sale of athletic, exercise, and physical fitness facility memberships by a health studio registered under ss. 501.012-501.019, Florida Statutes.
- (2) The Department of Revenue may, and all conditions are deemed met to, adopt emergency rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54, Florida Statutes, to administer this section.
- Section 2. For fiscal year 2014-2015, the sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Revenue for the purpose of administering this act.
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
