(9) Citizens Property Insurance Corporation may not impose
a 30-day waiting period for a policy to become effective when an
applicant has satisfied all conditions and requirements
necessary for Citizens Property Insurance Corporation to issue a
policy to the applicant if:
(a) The applicant's prior insurance policy was a lender-
placed insurance policy obtained by a bank or mortgage servicer
on the applicant's property when the applicant's property
insurance lapsed or the bank determined the applicant's
insurance to be insufficient.
(b) The lender-placed insurance was effective for 45 days
or longer.
(c) The cancellation of the policy was not due to
