A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the opening and closing of public schools; amending s. 1001.42, F.S.; authorizing a district school board to set an opening date for schools in the district to accommodate the completion of student classwork and assessments during the fall term; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (f) of subsection (4) of section 1001.42, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1001.42 Powers and duties of district school board.—The district school board, acting as a board, shall exercise all powers and perform all duties listed below:

- (4) ESTABLISHMENT, ORGANIZATION, AND OPERATION OF SCHOOLS.—Adopt and provide for the execution of plans for the establishment, organization, and operation of the schools of the district, including, but not limited to, the following:
- Adopt policies for the opening and closing of schools and fix uniform dates; however, beginning with the 2007-2008 school year, the opening date for schools in the district may not be earlier than 14 days before Labor Day each year. Notwithstanding this paragraph, a district school board may advance the opening date for schools in the district by the number of days necessary to enable students to complete all classwork and assessments for fall-term courses 5 days before Christmas Day.
