Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. This act shall be known as the "Greyhound Safety Act".

Section 2. Subsections (12) and (13) of section 550.2415, Florida Statutes, are renumbered as (15) and (16), respectively, paragraph (a) of subsection (1) is amended, paragraph (d) is added to that subsection, and new subsections (12), (13), and (14) are added to that section, to read:

550.2415 Racing of animals under certain conditions prohibited; penalties; exceptions.—

(1) (a) The racing of an animal that has been impermissibly medicated or determined to have a prohibited substance present is prohibited. It is a violation of this section for a person to

impermissibly medicate an animal or for an animal to have a prohibited substance present resulting in a positive test for such medications or substances based on samples taken from the animal before or immediately after the racing of that animal. Test results and the identities of the animals being tested and of their trainers and owners of record are confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and from s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution for 10 days after testing of all samples collected on a particular day has been completed and any positive test results derived from such samples have been reported to the director of the division or administrative action has been commenced.

- d) It is a violation of this section for a racing greyhound to have anabolic steroids present resulting in a positive test for such steroids based on samples taken from the greyhound immediately after the racing of that greyhound unless such steroids are used for birth control for the greyhound or the steroids are otherwise prescribed by a licensed veterinarian who is not employed by a greyhound race track.
- (12) (a) A greyhound racetrack must be maintained in a manner that provides safety for racing greyhounds. A greyhound racetrack must:
- 1. Maintain at all times a safe track surface that meets standards developed by the division.
 - 2. Install a safety device to remove the lure from the

51 racing surface.

- 3. Insulate all exposed electrical wires on the track and facility where greyhounds are able to come into contact with the wires.
- (b) The division shall adopt rules necessary to implement and enforce the safety requirements of this section.
- (13) Racing greyhounds shall be fed a high protein diet using the same quality of meat found in commercial pet foods.

 The meat may be mixed with top quality dry dog food and supplemented with vitamins, minerals, and nutritional enhancements to maintain the health, welfare, and fitness of the racing greyhounds.
- (14) The regulation of the welfare of racing greyhounds is preempted to the state. The court shall declare any ordinance or rule adopted in violation of this section by a county, municipality, or other local governmental entity invalid and shall issue a permanent injunction that prohibits the county, municipality, or other local governmental entity from enforcing such ordinance or rule.
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
