(1) The governing body of the district shall be the Immokalee board of commissioners, consisting of seven members, each of whom shall be a registered voter, resident of the district, and citizen of the United States. Members of the board of commissioners shall be appointed by the Governor for terms of 4 years and serve until the member's successor is appointed. Of

the initial board, two members shall serve a term of 2 years;
