An act relating to exemption of homesteads; contingent on the results of a certain election, amending s. 196.031, F.S.; increasing the additional exemption for certain homesteads; requiring the value of certain homestead exemptions be adjusted annually; or increasing the additional exemption for certain homesteads and requiring the value of certain homesteads be adjusted annually; providing effective dates.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Effective upon the effective date of the amendment to the State Constitution proposed by HJR 7015, 2024 Regular Session, or a similar joint resolution having substantially the same specific intent and purpose, if such amendment to the State Constitution is approved at the general election held in November 2024 or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that purpose, and if the amendment to the State Constitution proposed by HJR 7017, 2024 Regular Session, or a similar joint resolution having substantially the same specific intent and purpose is not approved at the general election held in November 2024 or at an earlier special election specifically authorized by law for that

The value of the exemption provided in this paragraph shall be reassessed annually on January 1 using the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, U.S. City Average, all items 1967=100, or successor reports for the preceding calendar year as initially reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Section 4. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
