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House Resolution

A resolution recognizing April 1, 2017, as "Dupuytren Disease Awareness Day" in Florida.

5 WHEREAS, Dupuytren disease is one of a group of diseases 6 resulting in fibrosis or scar tissue, which cripples hands, 7 diminishes quality of life, and affects the overall health of 8 millions of people worldwide, and

9 WHEREAS, more than ten million people in the United States
10 suffer bent fingers from Dupuytren contracture, with the disease
11 being more common in men than in women, and

12 WHEREAS, part of the biology of Dupuytren disease overlaps 13 with that of other fibrotic conditions, including cirrhosis of 14 the liver, pulmonary fibrosis, arteriosclerosis, and some 15 cancers, and

16 WHEREAS, the most common treatments for Dupuytren disease 17 are open surgery and minimally invasive procedures, such as 18 injections, with most contractures returning after treatment, 19 and

20 WHEREAS, there is currently no cure, and scientists and 21 physicians around the world are conducting research to develop 22 better treatments and to find a cure for this hereditary 23 disease, and

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24	WHEREAS, increasing awareness and education of Dupuytren
25	disease may lead to significant progress in the research of
26	finding the root cause and the cure, NOW, THEREFORE,
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28	Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of
29	Florida:
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31	That April 1, 2017, is recognized as "Dupuytren Disease
32	Awareness Day" in Florida.
