## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions of state government so as to prohibit state agencies from paying ransoms
- 3 in response to cyber attacks; to provide for a definition; to provide for related matters; to
- 4 provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

- 7 Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 8 provisions of state government, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

- 10 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'agency' means:
- 11 (1) The executive, judicial, or legislative branch of the state and any department, agency,
- board, bureau, office, commission, public corporation, and authority thereof;
- 13 (2) Every county, municipal corporation, school district, or other political subdivision
- of this state;
- 15 (3) Every department, agency, board, bureau, office, commission, authority, or similar
- body of each such county, municipal corporation, school district, or other political
- 17 <u>subdivision of this state; and</u>
- 18 (4) Every city, county, regional, or other authority established pursuant to the laws of this
- 19 state.
- 20 Such term shall not include any county, municipal corporation, or public corporation or any
- 21 <u>authority of a county, municipal corporation, or public corporation when such county,</u>
- 22 <u>municipal corporation</u>, public corporation, or authority is acting in the capacity of a
- 23 provider of wholesale or retail electric or gas service or in the capacity of a conduit through
- 24 <u>which a municipal corporation furnishes electric or gas service.</u>
- 25 (b) No agency shall pay any ransom in the event of a cyber attack against such agency."

26 SECTION 2.

- 27 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 28 without such approval.

29 SECTION 3

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
