A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding torts, so as to provide for immunity from civil damages for
- 3 certain conduct in regard to coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19); to provide for
- 4 definitions; to provide for an exception; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 51 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 9 provisions regarding torts, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>51-1-56.</u>
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 12 (1) 'COVID-19' means coronavirus disease 2019.
- (2) 'Person' means any individual, sole proprietorship, partnership, limited partnership,
- firm, corporation, limited liability company, association, or any other entity or organized
- group of individuals whether or not incorporated engaged in any activity with the object
- 16 <u>of:</u>
- 17 (A) Direct or indirect profit or gain, benefit, or advantage; or
- 18 (B) Nonprofit activity.
- 19 (b) No person shall be liable for any civil damages for the transmission of, or for injury
- 20 <u>or injuries resulting from, COVID-19 that arise out of activity with the object of direct or</u>
- 21 <u>indirect profit or gain, benefit, advantage, or nonprofit activity unless actions during such</u>
- 22 <u>activity were willful and wanton for such transmission or injury or injuries."</u>

23 SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
