A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to driving on right side of roadway, overtaking and passing, and following too
- 3 closely, so as to prohibit the operation of certain vehicles on certain highways that qualify
- 4 as dangerous; to provide for a definition; to require the installation by the Department of
- 5 Transportation of official traffic-control devices at the entrance and upon such highways; to
- 6 provide for violation and punishment; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 7 laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 9 SECTION 1.
- 10 Article 3 of Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- driving on right side of roadway, overtaking and passing, and following too closely, is
- 12 amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 13 "40-6-53.1.
- 14 (a) For purposes of this Code section, the term 'dangerous highway' means the portion of
- a highway designated by the Department of Transportation as a scenic highway that spans
- more than one county and that has upon it installed by such department fixed gates in order

17 to prohibit the entrance and operation of motor vehicles upon the highway during

- 18 hazardous weather conditions.
- 19 (b) No person shall operate a motor vehicle equipped with more than six wheels on a
- 20 <u>dangerous highway that has been properly marked pursuant to subsection (c) of this Code</u>
- 21 section.
- 22 (c) The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain official traffic-control
- 23 <u>devices upon and at the entrance of any dangerous highway giving notice of the prohibition</u>
- 24 provided for by this Code section.
- 25 (d) Any person that violates this Code section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
- 26 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$250.00."

SECTION 2.

28 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
