A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Subpart 1 of Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of
- 2 Georgia Annotated, relating to certificated professional personnel, so as to establish
- 3 standards for literacy coaches under the Professional Standards Commission; to provide for
- 4 definitions; to provide for legislative findings; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 7 SECTION 1.
- 8 Subpart 1 of Part 6 of Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 9 Annotated, relating to certificated professional personnel, is amended by adding a new Code
- 10 section to read as follows:
- 11 "<u>20-2-209.2.</u>

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- 12 (a) The General Assembly finds that the contributions of literacy coaches toward ensuring
- student success are very important to this state.
- 14 (b) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 15 (1) 'Andragogy' means the method and practice of teaching adult learners.

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16 (2) 'Literacy coach' means an instructional leader with specialized knowledge in the

- science of reading, evidence based practices, the English language, and how to work with
- 18 <u>teachers and students.</u>
- 19 (3) 'Pedagogy' means the method and practice of teaching children.
- 20 (c) The Professional Standards Commission is authorized and directed to establish the
- 21 Georgia Literacy Coach Certification Program to provide recognition to literacy coaches
- that meet the program's standards.
- 23 (d) The Professional Standards Commission shall establish criteria for a Georgia Literacy
- 24 Coach Certification. Such certification shall, at a minimum, include training in the use of
- 25 <u>effective methods in the following areas:</u>
- 26 (1) Planning, implementing, and analyzing standards based literacy instruction based on
- 27 <u>the science of reading and evidence based practices;</u>
- 28 (2) Collecting and using data on instructional practices to inform and implement
- 29 <u>professional learning opportunities; and</u>
- 30 (3) Andragogy and pedagogy.
- 31 (e) The Professional Standards Commission shall review the performance of each literacy
- coach who completes the training described in subsection (d) of this Code section and
- 33 determine whether such individual meets the criteria for Georgia Literacy Coach
- 34 <u>Certification</u>. If the Professional Standards Commission finds that a literary coach meets
- 35 the criteria, such individual shall be awarded a Georgia Literary Coach Certification. The
- 36 <u>Professional Standards Commission is authorized to develop rules and regulations</u>
- 37 governing such certification."

38 SECTION 2.

39 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
