A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to student health in elementary and secondary education, so as to require
- 3 local school systems to conduct suicide screenings on all students age eight through 18; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to student health in elementary and secondary education, is amended in Code Section
- 9 20-2-779.1, relating to suicide prevention and awareness training and no duty of care
- 10 imposed, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 11 "(d) Beginning in the 2023-2024 school year, each local school system shall require every
- student age eight through 18 to undergo a suicide screening at the beginning of each school
- vear. The Department of Education, in consultation with the Department of Behavioral
- Health and Developmental Disabilities, the Suicide Prevention Program established
- pursuant to Code Section 37-1-27, and suicide prevention experts, shall develop or identify
- one or more age-appropriate screening tools. Local school systems shall refer any students,

17 <u>as appropriate, to mental health services or programs based on the results of the</u>
18 <u>screenings."</u>

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
