The House Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security offers the following substitute to HB 202:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to penal institutions,
2	so as to require the commissioner of corrections to report certain information regarding
3	United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement detainers, offenses, and home countries
4	of persons who are confined under the authority of the Department of Corrections; to provide
5	for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	Title 42 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to penal institutions, is amended
9	in Article 1 of Chapter 1, relating to inmate policies, by adding a new Code section to read
10	as follows:
11	" <u>42-1-11.3.</u>
12	The commissioner shall, on the official website used by the department, publish a report
13	of aggregate data on United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement detainers,
14	offenses, and home countries of inmates who are not United States citizens and who are
15	confined under the authority of the department and, with regard to the total population in
16	confinement, the percentage that comprises persons who are not citizens of the United
17	States. Such report shall be first published on October 1, 2019, and every 90 days
18	thereafter; provided, however, that if the ninetieth day falls on a state holiday or Saturday
19	or Sunday, then such report shall be published the next business day."
20	SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
