A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-6-183 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 alteration of speed limits by local authorities, so as to decrease the lowest speed limit which
- 3 may be set by a local governing authority in an urban or residential district; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 40-6-183 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to alteration of
- 8 speed limits by local authorities, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 9 "(a) Whenever the governing authority of an incorporated municipality or county, in its
- 10 respective jurisdiction, determines on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation
- that the maximum vehicle speed permitted under this chapter is greater than is reasonable
- and safe under the conditions found to exist upon a highway or part of a highway under its
- jurisdiction, such authority may determine and declare a reasonable and safe maximum
- vehicle speed limit thereon which:
- 15 (1) Decreases the limit at intersections;
- 16 (2) Decreases the limit outside an urban or residential district, but not to less than 30
- miles per hour;
- 18 (3) Decreases the limit within an urban or residential district, but not to less than $\frac{25}{20}$
- miles per hour; or
- 20 (4) Decreases any speed limit where a special hazard or condition exists that requires
- lower speed for compliance with Code Section 40-6-180."

SECTION 2.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
