A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to health of students in elementary and secondary education, so as to
- 3 require testing of drinking water in public and private schools for lead contamination; to
- 4 provide for remediation plans or alternate sources of drinking water; to provide for rules and
- 5 regulations; to provide for an exemption; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 6 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 10 relating to health of students in elementary and secondary education, is amended by adding
- 11 a new Code section to read as follows:

- 13 (a) No later than December 31, 2017, every public and private school shall conduct testing
- of drinking water outlets for lead contamination. Such testing shall be conducted in
- accordance with rules and regulations established pursuant to subsection (c) of this Code
- 16 <u>section.</u>
- 17 (b) Where a finding of lead contamination is made, a school shall establish a remediation
- plan for or alternate source of drinking water.
- 19 (c) The Department of Education, in consultation with the Department of Public Health,
- 20 <u>shall establish rules and regulations regarding the testing of drinking water outlets and the</u>
- 21 <u>remediation of lead contamination as required pursuant to this Code section.</u>
- 22 (d) Public or private schools which are classified as public water systems pursuant to Parts
- 23 <u>141 and 142 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations shall be exempt from this Code</u>
- 24 section."
