BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

8 Code Section 50-14-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to meetings to be

9 open to public, limitation on action to contest agency action, recording, notice of time and

place, access to minutes, and telecommunications conferences, is amended by revising

subparagraph (e)(2)(B) as follows:

"(B)(i) The regular minutes of a meeting subject to this chapter shall be promptly recorded and such records shall be open to public inspection once approved as official by the agency or its committee, but in no case later than immediately following its next regular meeting; provided, however, that nothing contained in this chapter shall prohibit the earlier release of minutes, whether approved by the agency or not. Such minutes shall, at a minimum, include the names of the members present at the meeting, a description of any public comment period, including the name of every person providing public comment and a brief description of the commentary provided by each such person, a description of each motion or other proposal made, the identity of the persons making and seconding the motion or other proposal, and a record of all votes. The name of each person voting for or against a proposal shall be recorded. It shall be presumed that the action taken was approved by each person in attendance unless the minutes reflect the name of the persons voting against the proposal or abstaining.

26	(ii) Any video of a meeting made available by an agency on its website for public
27	viewing shall include the entire meeting, except for any executive sessions, and shall
28	include, but not be limited to, any public commentary portion of the meeting."

SECTION 2.
