# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 2 relating to landlord and tenant generally, so as to repeal Code Section 44-7-19, relating to 3 restrictions on rent regulation by local governments; to require landlords to provide at 4 least 60 days' notice to terminate certain tenancies; to provide for a short title; to provide for 5 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

#### 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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### **SECTION 1.**

8 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Tenant Protection Act."

## 9 SECTION 2.

10 Article 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 11 landlord and tenant generally, is amended by repealing Code Section 44-7-19, relating to 12 restrictions on rent regulation by local governments, in its entirety and designating said Code 13 section as reserved.

14	SECTION 3.
15	Said article is further amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
16	″ <u>44-7-25.</u>
17	Except when a tenant fails to pay the rent when it becomes due or otherwise violates the
18	terms of a rental agreement, a landlord may only terminate a fixed term residential tenancy
19	before the expiration of such tenancy if the landlord gives the tenant at least 60 days' notice
20	prior to the termination."
21	SECTION 4.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
