A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to state license requirements and regulations for manufacture, distribution, and
- 3 package sales of distilled spirits, so as to change the number of retail dealer licenses that a
- 4 person may hold or have a beneficial interest in; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 2 of Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state
- 9 license requirements and regulations for manufacture, distribution, and package sales of
- 10 distilled spirits, is amended by revising Code Section 3-4-21, relating to prohibition of
- 11 holding or having beneficial interest in more than two retail dealer licenses, as follows:
- 12 "3-4-21.
- 13 (a) No person shall be issued more than two 11 retail dealer licenses, nor shall any person
- be permitted to have a beneficial interest in more than two 11 retail dealer licenses issued
- under this chapter, regardless of the degree of such interest.
- 16 (b) For purposes of this Code section:
- 17 (1) The term 'person' shall include all members of a retail dealer licensee's family; and
- the term 'family' shall include any person related to the holder of the license within the
- first degree of consanguinity and affinity as computed according to the canon law.
- 20 (2) The beneficiaries of a trust shall be considered to have a beneficial interest in any
- business forming a part of the trust estate.
- 22 (c) Nothing contained in this Code section shall prohibit the reissuance of a valid retail
- dealer license if the license has been:
- 24 (1) Held prior to the creation of any of the above relationships by marriage; or
- 25 (2) Held prior to April 3, 1978."
