House Bill 576 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To create a board of elections and registration for Wilcox County and to provide for its

- 2 powers and duties; to provide for definitions; to provide for the composition of the board and
- 3 the selection and appointment of members; to provide for the qualification, terms, and
- 4 removal of members; to provide for oaths and privileges; to provide for meetings,
- 5 procedures, and vacancies; to relieve certain officers of powers and duties and to provide for
- 6 the transfer of functions to the newly created board; to provide for certain expenditures of
- 7 public funds; to provide for compensation of members of the board and personnel; to provide
- 8 for offices and equipment; to provide for the board's performance of certain functions and
- 9 duties for certain municipalities; to provide for related matters; to provide for submission for
- 10 preclearance under Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to
- provide effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

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- 14 Pursuant to subsection (b) of Code Section 21-2-40 of the O.C.G.A., there is created the
- 15 Board of Elections and Registration of Wilcox County, hereinafter referred to as "the board."
- 16 The board shall have the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the superintendent of
- 17 elections of Wilcox County under Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia
- 18 Election Code," currently being exercised by the judge of the Probate Court of Wilcox
- 19 County, and the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Board of Registrars of Wilcox
- 20 County under Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 The terms "election," "elector," "political party," "primary," "public office," "special
- 23 election," and "special primary" shall have the same meanings as set forth in Chapter 2 of
- 24 Title 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code," unless otherwise clearly apparent
- 25 from the text of this Act; and the term "commissioners" means the Board of Commissioners

of Wilcox County, "county" means Wilcox County, and "superior court" means the Superior

27 Court of Wilcox County.

28 SECTION 3.

- 29 (a) The board shall be composed of five members, each of whom shall be an elector and
- 30 resident of the county at the time of appointment and for at least one year prior thereto, and
- 31 who shall be appointed as provided in this section.
- 32 (b) One member of the board shall be appointed by the political party whose candidate for
- 33 the office of Governor at the last election for such office received the highest number of
- 34 votes cast for such office within the county. One member of the board shall be appointed
- 35 by the political party whose candidate for the office of Governor at the last election for such
- 36 office received the second highest number of votes cast for such office within the county.
- 37 Three members of the board shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners of Wilcox
- 38 County.
- 39 (c) One of the members appointed by the board of commissioners shall be designated as the
- 40 chairperson of the board.
- 41 (d) The initial appointments to the board shall be made at least 30 days prior to
- 42 January 1, 2014. The initial members and their successors shall be appointed for terms of
- 43 two years and until their respective successors are appointed and qualified. The term of each
- 44 initial member shall commence on January 1, 2014.

45 **SECTION 4.**

- 46 No person who holds elective public office shall be eligible to serve as a member of the
- 47 board during the term of such elective office, and the position of any member of the board
- 48 shall be deemed vacant upon such member's qualifying as a candidate for elective public
- 49 office.

50 **SECTION 5.**

- 51 The Board of Commissioners of Wilcox County and the respective political parties shall
- 52 certify their appointments to the board by filing an affidavit with the clerk of the superior
- 53 court no later than 15 days preceding the date upon which such members are to take office,
- 54 stating the name and residential address of the person appointed and certifying that such
- 55 member has been duly appointed as provided in this Act. The clerk of the superior court
- shall record each of such certifications on the minutes of the superior court and shall certify
- 57 the name of each such appointed member to the Secretary of State and provide for the
- 58 issuance of appropriate commissions to the members within the same time and in the same
- 59 manner as provided by law for registrars.

SECTION 6.

Each member of the board shall be eligible to serve successive terms, shall have the right to resign at any time by giving written notice of such resignation to the appointing body and to the clerk of the superior court, and shall be subject to removal from the board by the appointing body at any time, for cause, after notice and hearing, in the same manner and by the same authority as provided for the removal of registrars.

SECTION 7.

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In the event a vacancy occurs in the office of any appointed member before the expiration of his or her term, by removal, death, resignation, or otherwise, a successor shall be appointed to serve the remainder of the unexpired term, such appointment to be made in the same manner of appointment as provided for such position in Section 3 of this Act. The clerk of the superior court shall be notified of such interim appointments and record and certify such appointments in the same manner as the regular appointment of members.

73 **SECTION 8.**

Before entering upon the member's duties, each member shall take substantially the same oath as required by law for registrars and shall have the same privileges from arrest.

76 SECTION 9.

- (a) The board shall be authorized to organize itself, determine its procedural rules and regulations, adopt bylaws, specify policies for the functions and duties of its employees and poll workers, and otherwise take such action as is appropriate to the management of the affairs committed to its supervision; provided, however, that no such action shall conflict with state law. Action and decision by the board shall be by a majority of the members of the board. The chairperson of the board shall have sole authority, within the policies established by the full board, over retention, termination, and discipline of employees, as well as training of poll workers in primaries and elections, such poll workers to be appointed by the chairperson.
- 85 (b) The chairperson shall be authorized to employ such full-time and part-time employees,
- 86 including poll workers, as may be deemed necessary by the chairperson and as approved in
- 87 the annual budget adopted by the governing authority of Wilcox County.
- 88 (c) The board shall fix and establish, by appropriate resolution entered on its minutes,
- 89 directives governing the execution of matters within its jurisdiction. The board shall have
- 90 regular monthly meetings. Any specially called meeting shall be called by the chairperson
- 91 or any three members of the board. The board shall maintain a written record of policy
- 92 decisions amended to include additions or deletions. Such written records shall be made
- 93 available for the public to review.

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94	SECTION 10.
95	The board shall have the authority to contract with any municipality located within Wilcox
96	County for the holding by the board of any primary or election to be conducted within such
97	municipality.
98	SECTION 11.
99	Compensation for the members of the board, clerical assistants, and other employees shall be
100	fixed by the Board of Commissioners of Wilcox County. Such compensation shall be paid
101	wholly from county funds.
102	SECTION 12.
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103	The chairperson of the board shall be the chief executive officer of the board and shall
104	generally supervise, direct, and control the administration of the affairs of the board pursuant
105	to law and duly adopted resolutions of the board. The board shall fix and establish, by
106107	appropriate resolution entered on its minutes, directives governing the execution of matters
107	within its jurisdiction.
108	SECTION 13.
109	The Board of Commissioners of Wilcox County shall provide the board with such proper and
110	suitable offices, equipment, materials, and supplies and with such clerical assistance and other
111	employees as the Board of Commissioners of Wilcox County shall deem appropriate.
112	SECTION 14.
113	On January 1, 2014, the superintendent of elections and the board of registrars shall be
114	relieved of all powers and duties to which the board succeeds by the provisions of this Act and
115	shall deliver to the board all equipment, supplies, materials, books, papers, records, and
116	facilities pertaining to such powers and duties. On such date, the Board of Registrars of
117	Wilcox County shall stand abolished. All elections conducted during 2013 shall be conducted
118	by the superintendent of elections and the board of registrars.
119	SECTION 15.
120	This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2013.
120	This first shall seeding effective on wary 1, 2015.

SECTION 15.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.

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
