A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Title 34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to labor and industrial
2	relations, so as to provide that rights, powers, and responsibilities of professional employer
3	organizations are not to be construed to exempt any person from the licensure requirements
4	of Chapter 23 of Title 33; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
5	other purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	Title 34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to labor and industrial relations,
9	is amended in Code Section 34-7-6, relating to rights, powers, and responsibilities of
10	professional employer organizations, by revising subsection (b) as follows:
11	"(b) A professional employer organization may collect information to evaluate costs; may
12	obtain life, accident and sickness, disability income, workers' compensation, and other
13	types of insurance coverage; may establish retirement plans; may have other types of
14	employee benefits; and may discuss such benefits with prospective coemployers and their
15	employees; provided, however, that nothing in this Code section shall be construed to
16	exempt any person from the provisions and licensure requirements of Chapter 23 of
17	Title 33 or any other applicable requirements of law or regulation."
