A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 2 provisions regarding holidays and observances, so as to declare June 12 of each year as
- 3 "Women Veterans Day"; to provide for legislative findings; to provide for related matters;
- 4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions
- 8 regarding holidays and observances, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 "1-4-23.
- 11 (a) The General Assembly finds that:
- 12 (1) Women have rendered their compassionate and dedicated services to the various
- branches of the United States military;
- 14 (2) Women risk their lives and now fight alongside male servicemen. Women have
- historically served in noncombat capacities in various branches of the military, despite
- not being recognized as official military members;
- 17 (3) Women veterans are still widely unrecognized for their contributions, and suffer from
- many of the same issues of their fellow male servicemen, including homelessness, post
- 19 <u>traumatic stress syndrome, financial distress, and other issues specific to women veterans;</u>
- 20 <u>and</u>
- 21 (4) Over 90,000 women veterans are Georgia citizens, and they deserve recognition for
- 22 <u>their contributions to the nation.</u>
- 23 (b) June 12 of each year is declared to be 'Women Veterans Day' in Georgia."
- SECTION 2.
- 25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
