A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to state government, so as to provide that this state shall at all
- 3 times observe the standard time of the United States; to exempt this state from the daylight
- 4 savings advancement of time provisions of the United States Code; to provide for an
- 5 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 9 provisions relative to state government, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 "<u>50-1-10.</u>
- 12 This state, including all political subdivisions thereof, shall at all times observe the standard
- time of the United States as provided for in 15 U.S.C. Sections 261 through 263. This state
- shall be exempt from the advancement of time provisions as provided for in 15 U.S.C.
- 15 Section 260a."

16 SECTION 2.

- 17 This Act shall become effective immediately after the expiration of the advancement of time
- as provided for in 15 U.S.C. Section 260a in the year of 2019 or on December 31, 2019,
- 19 whichever occurs first.

SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
