## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To repeal an Act creating and establishing the Saint Marys Airport Authority, approved
- 2 March 4, 1964 (Ga. L. 1964, p. 2438), as amended by an Act approved April 11, 1979 (Ga.
- 3 L. 1979, p. 3278); to provide for the assets and liabilities thereof; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to provide a specific repealer; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act creating and establishing the Saint Marys Airport Authority, approved March 4, 1964
- 9 (Ga. L. 1964, p. 2438), as amended by an Act approved April 11, 1979 (Ga. L. 1979,
- 10 p. 3278), is hereby repealed in its entirety.

11 SECTION 2.

- 12 There are no known assets of the Saint Marys Airport Authority, but to the extent any assets
- 13 of the Saint Marys Airport Authority exist, such assets shall devolve to the City of Saint
- 14 Marys automatically and without further action. The governing body of the City of Saint
- 15 Marys is authorized to execute any deeds or instruments of conveyance required to place title
- of such assets into the name of the City of Saint Marys and is authorized to do so in the name
- 17 of the Saint Marys Airport Authority. There are no known obligations of the Saint Marys
- 18 Airport Authority, but to the extent any obligations of the Saint Marys Airport Authority
- 19 exist, such obligations shall be transferred to and assumed by the City of Saint Marys by such
- 20 instruments as may be required to maintain the same. The governing body of the City of
- 21 Saint Marys is authorized to execute any such instruments required to transfer such
- 22 obligations into the name of the City of Saint Marys and is authorized to do so in the name
- 23 of the Saint Marys Airport Authority.
