BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 20-2-2114 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to qualifications
- 8 for the Georgia Special Needs Scholarship Program, is amended by revising paragraph (3)
- 9 of subsection (a) as follows:
- 10 ''(3) The student:
- 11 (A) Has spent the prior school year in attendance at a Georgia public school; provided,
- however, that this requirement shall not apply if:
- 13 (i) The the student's parent is an active duty military service member stationed in
- Georgia within the previous year; or
- 15 (ii) The student previously qualified for a scholarship pursuant to this article; and
- 16 (B) Has an Individualized Education Program written in accordance with federal and
- state laws and regulations; provided, however, that the State Board of Education shall
- be authorized to require a local board of education to expedite the development of an
- 19 Individualized Education Program and to waive the prior school year requirement
- 20 contained in subparagraph (A) of this paragraph, in its sole discretion, on a case-by-case
- basis for specific medical needs of the student upon the request of a parent or guardian
- Program is required by the state board pursuant to this subparagraph, the state board

in accordance with state board procedures. If an expedited Individualized Education

- 24 may additionally require such expedited process to be completed prior to the beginning
- of the school year. The State Board of Education shall provide an annual report by
