A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 20-3-374 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 service cancelable loan fund and authorized types of service cancelable educational loans
- 3 financed by state funds and issued by the Georgia Student Finance Authority, so as to include
- 4 graduate degree programs; to require application for additional educational assistance
- 5 programs; to implement a two-year service requirement; to correct references; to provide for
- 6 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 Code Section 20-3-374 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to service

10 cancelable loan fund and authorized types of service cancelable educational loans financed

by state funds and issued by the Georgia Student Finance Authority, is amended by revising

paragraph (2) of subsection (b) as follows:

"(2) Georgia National Guard members.

- 14 (A) The authority is authorized to make service cancelable educational loans to
- 15 residents of Georgia who are eligible members of the Georgia National Guard and who
- are enrolled at the undergraduate level in a degree program in a private or public
- 17 college or public postsecondary technical or vocational school located in the state at an
- 18 <u>eligible postsecondary institution, eligible private postsecondary institution, or eligible</u>
- 19 <u>public postsecondary institution, as those terms are defined in Code Section 20-3-519.</u>
- 20 Members of the Georgia National Guard who are in good standing according to
- applicable regulations of the National Guard shall be eligible to apply for a loan.
- 22 (B) Prior to making application for the service cancelable educational loan, an
- 23 <u>applicant shall complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid and make</u>
- 24 <u>application for all other available grants, scholarships, tuition assistance, and U.S.</u>
- 25 <u>Department of Veterans Affairs educational benefits that have not been transferred to</u>
- dependents.

(C) Such loans shall be on the terms and conditions set by the authority in consultation with the Department of Defense, provided that any such loan, when combined with any other available grants, scholarships, tuition assistance, and U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs educational benefits, shall not exceed an amount equal to the actual tuition charged to the recipient for the period of enrollment in an educational institution or the highest undergraduate in-state tuition charged by the University of Georgia a postsecondary institution governed by the board of regents for the period of enrollment at the university postsecondary institution, whichever is less. A loan recipient shall not be eligible to receive loan assistance provided for in this paragraph for <u>not</u> more than five academic years 120 semester hours of study. Educational loans may be made to full-time and half-time part-time students. (D) Upon the recipient's attainment of a baccalaureate graduate degree from an institution or cessation of status as an active member of the Georgia National Guard, whichever occurs first, eligibility to apply for the loan provided by this paragraph shall be discontinued. (E) The loan provided by this paragraph may shall be suspended at the discretion of by the authority for a recipient's failure to maintain good military standing as an active member for the period required in subparagraph (F) of this paragraph or failure to maintain sufficient academic standing and good academic progress and program pursuit. Loans If the recipient fails to maintain good standing as an active member of the Georgia National Guard for the required period or fails to maintain sufficient academic standing and good academic progress and program pursuit, loans made under this paragraph shall be repayable in cash, with interest thereon, or, upon. (F) Upon satisfactory completion of a quarter, semester, year, or other period of study as determined by the authority; graduation; termination of enrollment in school; or termination of this assistance with approval of the authority, the loan shall be canceled in consideration of the student's retaining membership in good standing in the Georgia National Guard during the for a period in of two years following the last period of study <u>for</u> which the loan is applicable. <u>This two-year service requirement may be waived by</u> the adjutant general of Georgia for good cause according to applicable regulations of the Georgia National Guard. (G) The adjutant general of Georgia shall certify eligibility and termination of eligibility of students for educational loans and eligibility for cancellation of educational loans by members of the Georgia National Guard in accordance with regulations of the authority;"
