A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 6 of Chapter 3 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to property owners' associations, so as to prohibit certain restrictions on political
- 3 signs; to provide for a short title; to provide for legislative findings and a purpose; to provide
- 4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
- 6 SECTION 1.
- 7 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Lawful Expression of Speech Act."
- 8 SECTION 2.
- 9 The Georgia General Assembly finds that the proliferation of signs during the period
- 10 preceding elections and referenda can stifle freedom of expression in residential areas subject
- 11 to declarations of property owners' associations.
- 12 SECTION 3.
- 13 Article 6 of Chapter 3 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 14 property owners' associations, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 15 "<u>44-3-236.</u>
- During the 30 days preceding any primary election, general election, special election, or
- other election or referendum, any provision in a declaration that prohibits the placement
- of three or fewer signs that do not each exceed six square feet in surface area on any lot
- 19 <u>shall be void and unenforceable."</u>
- SECTION 4.
- 21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
