A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 48-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 excise tax on tobacco products, so as to increase the amount of such tax with respect to
- 3 certain tobacco products; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 4 other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 48-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the excise tax
- 8 on tobacco products, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 9 "(a) An excise tax, in addition to all other taxes of every kind imposed by law, is imposed
- upon the sale, receipt, purchase, possession, consumption, handling, distribution, or use of
- cigars, cigarettes, and loose or smokeless tobacco in this state at the following rates:
- 12 (1) Little cigars: two and one-half mills each;
- 13 (2) All cigars other than little cigars: 23 42 percent of the wholesale cost price, exclusive
- of any trade, cash, or other discounts or any promotion, advertising, display, or similar
- 15 allowances;
- 16 (3) Cigarettes: $37 \neq \$1.87$ per pack of 20 cigarettes and a like rate, pro rata, for other size
- 17 packages; and
- 18 (4) Loose or smokeless tobacco: 10 42 percent of the wholesale cost price, exclusive of
- any trade, cash, or other discounts or any promotion, advertising, display, or similar
- 20 allowances."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
