A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 27-1-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 definitions regarding game and fish, so as to provide that full-time military personnel on
- active duty and their dependents shall be considered residents of this state for procuring 3
- 4 certain hunting and fishing licenses in this state; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 6

7 **SECTION 1.**

- 8 Code Section 27-1-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
- 9 regarding game and fish, is amended by revising paragraph (60) as follows:
- 10 "(60) 'Resident' means any citizens citizen of the United States who has been domiciled
- 11 within the State of Georgia for a period of at least three months. For purposes of issuing
- 12 or procuring the noncommercial hunting and fishing licenses required by this title,
- 13 residents the term 'resident' shall include full-time military personnel on active duty who
- 14 list Georgia as their home of record in their official military files or who are stationed at
- 15 a military base located in Georgia and the dependents of such military personnel;
- provided, however, that requirements for residency as defined in paragraph (5) of 17 subsection (e) of Code Section 27-2-3.1 shall apply to such military personnel and their
- 18 dependents for all lifetime license types listed in Code Section 27-2-3.1 that are only
- 19 available to residents. Requirements for residency as defined in paragraph (5) of
- subsection (e) of Code Section 27-2-3.1 shall also apply to such military personnel and 20
- their dependents for all honorary license types listed in Code Section 27-2-4 and to the 21
- 22 landowner exemption in subsection (b) of Code Section 27-2-1, provided that the
- domicile requirement shall be a period of at least three months." 23

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 25
