## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 50-16-34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 powers and duties of State Properties Commission generally, so as to allow the commission
- 3 to use an opinion of value in the valuation of state property where a conveyance of the
- 4 property by the state is for the sole and direct benefit to the state; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 50-16-34 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to powers and
- 9 duties of State Properties Commission generally, is amended by revising paragraph (7) as
- 10 follows:

- 11 "(7) Have prepared a thorough report of such data as will enable the commission to arrive
- at a fair valuation of the property; and to include within the report either an opinion of the
- value if the conveyance is to a public entity <u>or for the purposes of constructing, installing,</u>
- operating, and maintaining utilities which solely and directly benefit the state or at least
- one written appraisal of the value of the property if the conveyance is to a private entity,
- which appraisal shall be made by a person or persons familiar with property values in the
- area where the property is situated and who is a member of a nationally recognized
