- 7 purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license
- 11 plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, causes, agencies, funds, or
- 12 nonprofit corporations, is amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (n) to read as
- 13 follows:
- 14 "(7) A special license plate promoting the conservation and enhancement of waterfowl
- populations and their habitats. The funds raised by the sale of this special license plate
- shall be disbursed to the Wildlife Resources Division of the Department of Natural
- 17 Resources for the purposes of waterfowl habitat restoration, waterfowl research, and
- waterfowl management programs."
- 19 SECTION 2.
- 20 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2019.
- SECTION 3.
- 22 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(n) of the
- 23 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the
- 24 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.

25 SECTION 4.

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
