A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing for the Board of Education of Bartow County, approved 2 March 30, 1987 (Ga. L. 1987, p. 4915), as amended, particularly by an Act approved 3 April 5, 2012 (Ga. L. 2012, p. 4818), so as to change the description of the education 4 districts; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to provide for continuation in office of 5 current members; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other 6 purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

9 An Act providing for the Board of Education of Bartow County, approved March 30, 1987
10 (Ga. L. 1987, p. 4915), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 5, 2012
11 (Ga. L. 2012, p. 4818), is amended by revising subsections (b), (c), and (c.1) of Section 3
12 as follows:

13 "(b) For purposes of electing members of the board of education, the Bartow County 14 School District is divided into five education districts. One member of the board shall be 15 elected from each such district. The five education districts shall be and correspond to 16 those five numbered districts described in and attached to and made a part of this Act and 17 further identified as 'Plan: bartowsb-2019 Plan Type: Local Administrator: Bartow User: 18 Gina'.

19 (c)(1) For the purposes of such plan:

(A) The term 'VTD' shall mean and describe the same geographical boundaries as
provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial
census of 2010 for the State of Georgia. The separate numeric designations in a district
description which are underneath a VTD heading shall mean and describe individual
Blocks within a VTD as provided in the report of the Bureau of the Census for the
United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia; and

- (B) Except as otherwise provided in the description of any district, whenever the
 description of any district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical
 boundaries of that city as shown on the census maps for the United States decennial
 census of 2010 for the State of Georgia.
- 30 (2) Any part of the Bartow County School District which is not included in any district
 31 described in subsection (b) of this section shall be included within that district contiguous
 32 to such part which contains the least population according to the United States decennial
 33 census of 2010 for the State of Georgia.
- (3) Any part of the Bartow County School District which is described in subsection (b)
 of this section as being included in a particular district shall nevertheless not be included
 within such district if such part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous
 part shall instead be included within that district contiguous to such part which contains
 the least population according to the United States decennial census of 2010 for the State
 of Georgia.
- 40 (c.1) Education Districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5, as they existed immediately prior to the effective
 41 date of this subsection, shall continue to be designated as Education Districts 1, 2, 3, 4,
 42 and 5, respectively, but as newly described under subsection (b) of this section, and on and
 43 after the effective date of this subsection, such members of the board serving from those
 44 former education districts shall be deemed to be serving from and representing their
 45 respective districts as newly described under subsection (b) of this section."
- 45 respective districts as newry described under subsection (b) of this section.

Those members of the Board of Education of Bartow County who are serving as such on the effective date of this Act and any person elected to fill a vacancy in any such office shall continue to serve as such members until the regular expiration of their respective terms of office and upon the election and qualification of their respective successors.
